Harrisburg, Pa. – The Pennsylvania Bankers Association (PA Bankers) applauds Governor Josh Shapiro for signing Senate Bill 1231 (Act No. 64 of 2024). This new law modernizes Pennsylvania's trust laws regarding directed trusts and trust termination and aims to lower administrative costs and burdens, ensuring that more trust income is available for beneficiaries in a timely manner.
